

Proposed Support Models

- SWG establishes a "blanket" contract with a Lustre support vendor or vendors
 - Members access support through a portal providing a consistent interface regardless of the vendors
 - Ability to offer cafeteria-style coverage depending on a member's needs
 - For example, support could be based on the number of OSSs (high end) or Lustre as a "black box" (low end)
- SWG provides members with a support RFP/SOW package which is executed by each member site
 - SOW would include requirement to submit bug fixes to OpenSFS
