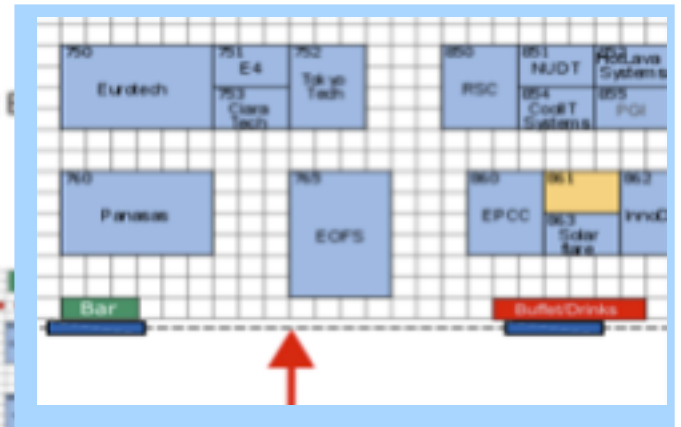
## Wording of the Board decision concerning the relationship between EOFS and the Exascale I/O interfaces workgroup
