Transitioning from “Save Lustre!” to “Expand Lustre!”

OpenSFS - a retrospective

- OpenSFS was formed to address the vacuum created when Oracle backed away from Lustre
- Multiple organizations that relied upon Lustre banded together to ensure that adequate funding would be made available to keep Lustre alive
 - Our first step was to fund NRE development of core Lustre features to address metadata scalability issues
 - Our second step was to fund community releases on behalf of the community
- Other communities also arose to help ensure Lustre would survive, notably HPCFS and EOFS
- OpenSFS established the community director board seat
 - HPCFS members joined OpenSFS
- OpenSFS and EOFS formed a strategic alliance

OpenSFS was critical for continuing to evolve the technology; as a result, the market place has matured

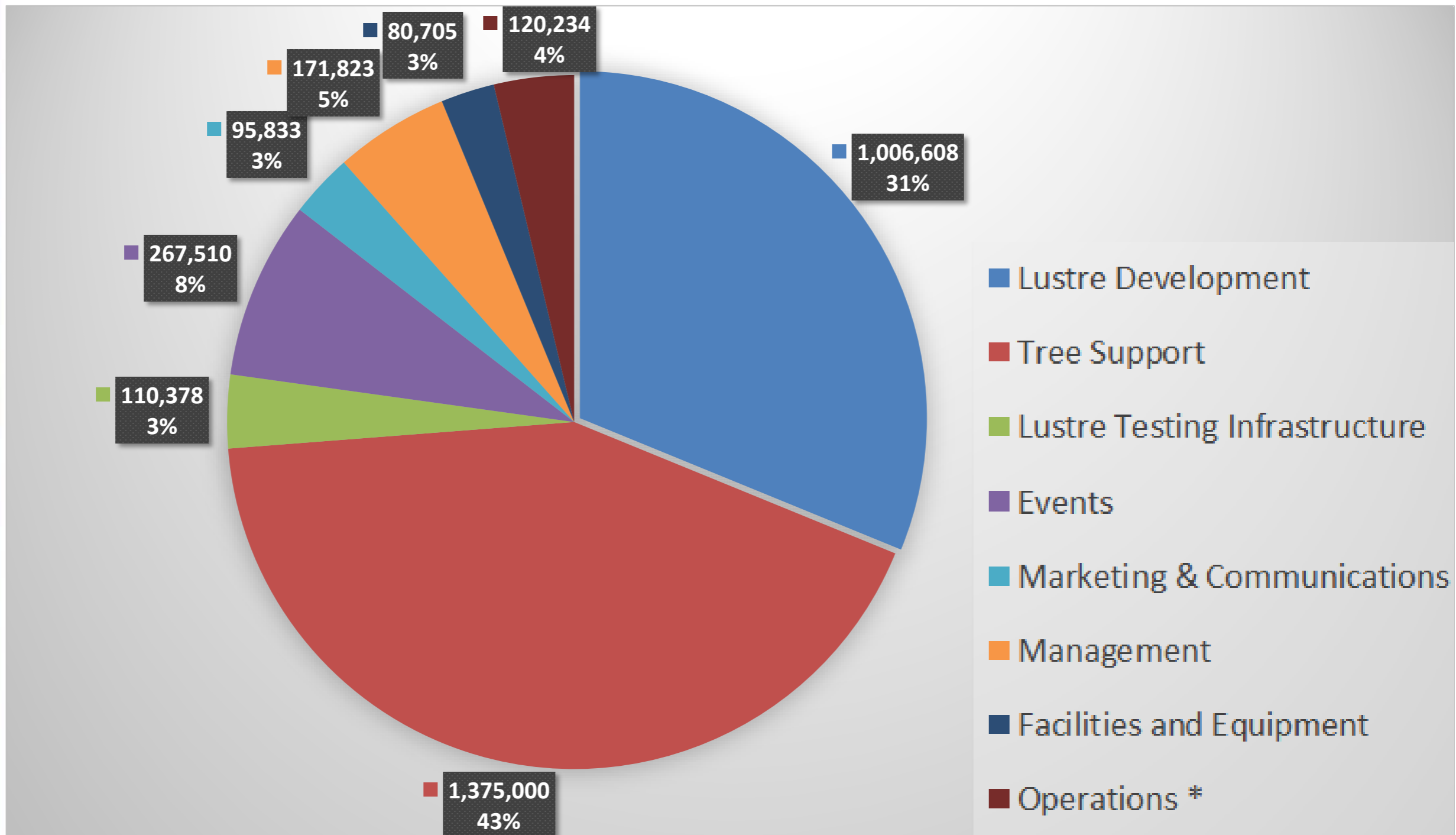
Save Lustre has worked!

- The Lustre community has matured
- Fortune 500 companies are now in the mix with Intel's acquisition of Whamcloud and more recently of Seagate's acquisition of Xyratex

2013 Was A Big Year

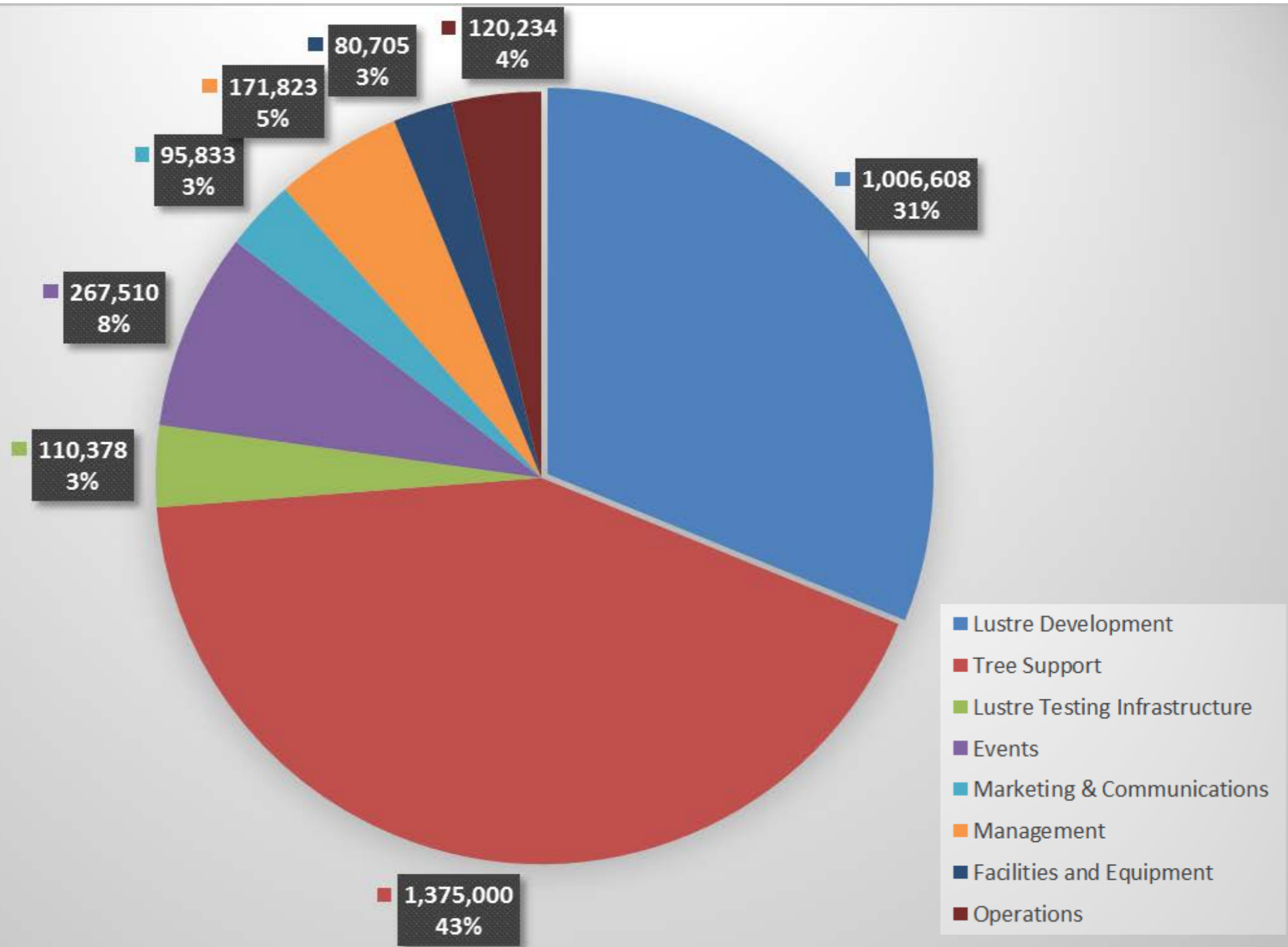
- Major releases of Lustre 2.4 and 2.5

Now We Need to Expand the Lustre Ecosystem!

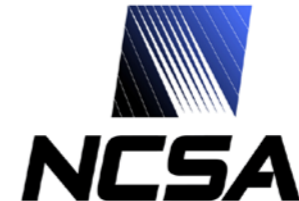
- Promote broader participation at ALL levels

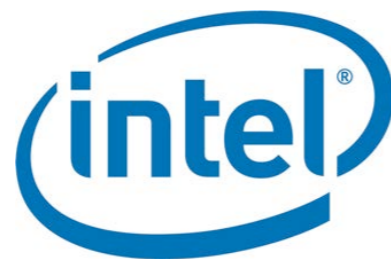
